Guidelines for manuscript preparation

1. Articles must be written in Bengali or in English. They must be restricted to 3500-7000 words. Each articles must be preceded by an abstract elucidating the goals, questions and findings of the study, in not more than 150 words.
2. Spellings of Bengali words should follow most recent guidelines provided by the Bangla Academy, West Bengal, India / Bangla Academy, Dacca, Bangladesh. In case of quotations and excerpts, however, original versions must be maintained.
3. If the word count of the quotations exceeds beyond 25 words, it must be presented in a separate paragraph. Quotations of poetic verses must maintain their original format.
4. Quotations borrowed from poetry-short story-novel-play and other non-fictional work must be followed by their source. Citations must follow the format:
(কাজী নজরুল ইসলাম, 'অগ্নি-বীণা', ২০১৪ : ২৩)
5. Quotation or paraphrased excerpts borrowed from any other source must be cited as follows:
(মাহবুবুল হক ২০১০ : ৪৭)

6. References at the end of the manuscript should enlist the list of publications in Bengali first, followed by that in English. References should be ordered by the names of the authors, arranged alphabetically. Titles of essays and articles must be enclosed within single quotation marks (' '). Titles of books, magazines, journals, periodicals and other sources should be *Italicised*. For magazines, journals and periodicals, their respective years and dates of publication, Issues and the names of their respective editors must be included. For instance

- সিরাজুল ইসলাম চৌধুরী (২০১১), 'উন্মুক্ত পথের যাত্রী', কালের খেলা সমকালের শুক্রবার সাময়িকী, (সম্পাদক : গোলাম সারোয়ার), ২০মে ঢাকা

7. Authors must prepare 2 (two) copies of digitally composed version of the manuscript as well as 1 (one) softcopy. Display dimensions of the article must be in A4 format, text typed in 14 point, Sutony MJ font style. Line spacing and paragraph spacing must be 1.5 and Auto, respectively. English manuscripts must be typed in 12 point, Times New Roman font style; line spacing and paragraph spacing must be 1.5 and Auto, respectively.

8. Authors must **not** include their full name and affiliation in the manuscript. Author details must be sent in a separate document.

9. Manuscripts are solicited, exclusively from higher educationists, Nazrul-scholars, research scholar, M.Phil and PhD level researchers.

10. Any modification / addition / deletion as suggested by the reviewers must be incorporated into the original manuscript and re-submitted, strictly maintaining the deadline provided by the editorial board.

11. Authors would receive copies of the journal on its publication. Manuscripts submitted, selected for publication or otherwise, shall not be returned to the authors.

12. Authors must take full responsibility of the content of their articles, potentially published in the Nazrul-Journal.
